Rent bicycles from **Sun & Fun Cycles** and cruise along the beachside promenade, an ideal spot for people-watching. Choose from traditional beach cruisers or "low rider" bicycles that are a hit with children. Or, fit the whole family into a canopy-covered, four-wheeled surrey that seats four.

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Or, simply kick back in a cabana and let the soothing sound of the ocean carry you away.

As the sun sets, head over to the outdoor **Hollywood Beach Theater**, which hosts live musical performances and festivals. End the evening with dinner at a nearby café, like the family-friendly **Broadwalk Restaurant & Grille**. The area is even a Wi-Fi hotspot.
